2015 EMPLOYER SATISFACTION SURVEY SUMMARY RESULTS REPORT

1. Introduction


- University of Information Technology (UIT) conducts employer survey as a way of assessing the realization of the programme educational objectives. By doing this, employers are given the chance of evaluating the performance of the employees who are UIT graduates. The survey includes assessment on quality of work, productivity, work attitude, commitment and compliance to company rules. Hence, this report summarizes the results of the employers' evaluation of the UIT graduates.
- The survey was conducted from November 13 to December 20, 2015.
- Most of the survey respondents are HR managers/ training supervisors/ heads of companies/ organizations/ institutions where the UIT graduates are working.
- The UIT Rector established the Organization Board to collect employer's feedback, consisting of representatives from faculties, the Office of Inspection-Legal Affairs and Quality Assurance and the Office of Students Affairs. The survey invitation and questionnaire were emailed or sent directly to all employers.
- The survey was 5 questions in length, including assessment on quality of work, productivity, work attitude, commitment and compliance to company rules, and 2 questions for open-ended comments.

2.1. The number of employer respondents




