EMPLOYERS SATISFACTION SURVVEY SUMMARY RESULTS REPORT 2020

1. Introduction

University of Information Technology (UIT) conducts employer survey as a way of assessing UIT quality of training:

- To understand about recruitment requirements of employers to compare with curriculum in UIT.
- Modify and expand more knowledge and skills for students
- Based on this results for survey, UIT has a second chance to consider and improve learning and teaching process
- The survey was conducted from August 25th to September 15th, 2020.
- Rector of UIT established the Quality Assurance Team to collect employer's feedback, consisting of representatives from faculties, the Office of Inspection-Legal Affairs and Quality Assurance and the Office of Students Affairs. The survey questionnaires were sent by email or directly to all employers.
- The survey was 6 questions in length, including: the level of satisfaction about employees, the priority of recruitment UIT alumni, cooperation between both 2 parties, trendy careers of computer area or IT and 2 remarks for UIT alumni strengthweak.

2. Results of survey

2.1. The number of employers responsed.

In 2020, Quality Assurance Team (QAT) conducted a survey and received the feedbacks of 59 units in which alumni are working. The presentation of the units are directors, head of marketing/HR departments, ... The number of employers responsed is the highest in years

Overall, the survey recorded some important from employers.






Chart 1. Kinds of companies



2.4. Extra courses that UIT alumni are trained in companies




2.5. Starting salary

Participants provided their current starting salaries for UIT's alumni. The data from the 42 units showed that the salaries for UIT's alumni from 7 million Vietnam dong to above 20 million Vietnam Dong (VND).


