SUMMARY REPORT: SURVEY OF SENIOR STUDENTS ON THE COURSE

(for the 2nd Graduation in 2017)

1. Introduction

- The survey was designed to help gather formative feedback from senior students that can be used towards on-going improvements in the quality of course design and delivery as well as student learning experiences in the University of Information Technology (UIT).
- The survey was conducted on November 30 December 17, 2017.
- Students completed the online questionnaire at http://survey.uit.edu.vn operated by the Office of Inspection-Legal Affairs-Quality Assurance and the Office of Data Management and Information Technology.
- The survey respondents were graduates in the 2nd Graduation Ceremony 2017.
- The questionnaire with 27 criteria was based on Likert scale 4 levels: 1- Not good/ Not satisfied, 2- Average, 3- Good/ Satisfied, 4- Very good/ Very satisfied, and No comment. In addition, there were questions about the employment situation of graduates and additional comments.
- The survey data was analyzed by SPSS, Excel.


2.1. Number of senior students in the feedback



2.2. The reasons students don't graduate on time

There are 43.4% (69/159) of full-time students don't complete their bachelor's degree on time, 44.0% (70/159) graduates on time, 12.6% (20/159) of graduates prior to UIT's deadline.


Some of the causes of taking so long to graduate which students mentioned in the survey:






2.3. The employment situation of graduates


There are about 86.2% (137/159) of graduates found full-time employment before their graduation; 13.8% (22/159) of graduates have not yet found a job.



2.4. Evaluation on the amount of the curriculum




2.5. Self-assessments of achievement of curriculum's learning outcomes




2.6. Assessment and Comments on the Course (Mean)


- Goals and Curriculum (8 criteria)




- **Lecturers** (7 criteria)
